Sununu Presents Housing Tax Credit Award

Maureen Beauregard, President of Families in Transition (FIT) accepts a tax credit excellence award from the Affordable Housing Tax Credit Coalition (AHTCC) presented by United States Senator John E. Sununu at a Capitol Hill ceremony on May 18, 2005. FIT received the honorable mention award for its Concord program, a low-income housing tax credit development project for homeless women with and without children.

“Families in Transition’s Bicentennial Square project performs an invaluable community function by helping the Concord community provide crucial housing and transitional services for women in need,” said Sununu who delivered remarks at AHTCC’s Charles L. Edson Tax Credit Excellence Awards luncheon.

The New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority nominated FIT to receive the award based on criteria established by AHTCC which included: project location, services available to tenants beyond housing, programs to encourage self-sufficiency, unique project design features, and community support for the initiative.
