On Thursday, May 3, Families in Transition (FIT), a nonprofit homeless services organization, is holding our biggest fundraising event of 2018, our cinco de mayo celebration, to raise money and awareness to help end homelessness in New Hampshire.

Your participation not only helps homeless individuals and families, but includes you in a uniquely effective marketing opportunity, giving you wide visibility among more than 400 attendees, including successful business owners, active community leaders, and highly distinguished invited guests.
